#### Maritime Environmental Excellence Awards



- Environmental Performance: SSA Marine
  - For voluntary installing LED lighting upgrades at Terminal 18, making use of Seattle City Light incentives
    - Achieved 65% energy reduction while improving lighting quality, improving worker safety, and reducing off-site light impacts on residential communities and natural habitats
    - Invested in state-of-the-art system to gain longerterm benefits and more efficient maintenance and operation



### Maritime Environmental Excellence Awards




- Environmental Education & Outreach: Dirt Corps LLC
  - For supporting Port environmental, equity, and environmental justice goals through education and outreach programs for adults, youth, and minorities
    - Implemented a pilot program to teach shoreline restoration skills along the Duwamish River and Elliot Bay to over 80 youth and adults
    - Trained youth and adults in leadership, aquatic horticulture, shoreline restoration, salmon habitat and restoration, and environmental justice

# Maritime Small Business Recognition



- Environmental Education & Outreach: Orcasound Hydrophone Network
  - A small non-profit organization, for convening 13 member organizations in the Puget Sound region to deploy hydrophones and document orca sounds
    - Data advances understanding of the stresses of underwater noise to Southern Resident Killer Whales and is shared with the public to learn about orca populations and noise impacts
    - Their role has helped to consolidate the impacts of other small organizations that track Orca sounds and noise impacts upon them





### Maritime Honorable Mentions

- Environmental Performance: Norwegian Cruise Line Holdings
- NCLH NORWEGIAN CRUISE LINE HOLDINGS LTD.
- For instituting a wide-ranging environmental program that includes waste reduction and voluntarily conducting underwater sound surveys for cruise vessels that visit Puget Sound
- Environmental Education & Outreach: Just Health Action
  - For conducting a community-based participatory action program that combines environmental and human health principles and directly engages Duwamish Valley community members







### Aviation Environmental Excellence Awards

- Environmental Performance: Alaska Airlines
  - For voluntary LED lighting upgrades at airport maintenance hangars and waste reduction
    - Reduced hangar energy consumption 1M kWh (70% cut), cut ghg emissions 11 tons, and lowered energy utility costs \$60,000/yr.
    - Leveraged BPA/Port energy incentive rebate to offset project costs 33%
    - Eliminated 22 million plastic straws & stir sticks from inflight beverage service
    - #FILLBEFOREYOUFLY campaign promoted reusable bottles in partnership with Bonneville Environmental Foundation

  - For extensive donations of restaurant food,
     equipment, and furniture, and waste reduction
    - Donated 7,594 meals to local food bank
    - Donated surplus equipment & materials to Habitat for Humanity, Highline Schools Foundation, and local small businesses
    - Recycled ~10,000 lbs. of metal restaurant equipment
    - Reduced waste by converting to reusable plates at Re'Lish and Dungeness Bay restaurants
    - Partnered Starbucks to pilot strawless lids and shifted to on-request only straws

# **Aviation Small Business Recognition**

- Environmental Performance: Whidbey SeaTac Shuttle
  - A small and veteran owned business, for converting fleet to alternative fuel, using high performance tires, and recycling waste
    - Converted remaining three vehicles from gasoline to propane, cutting ghg emissions by 164 tons
    - Used silica-based tires to improve fuel economy and extend tire lifespan
    - Recycled ~50 lbs./wk. through passenger and employee recycling programs



# **Aviation Small Business Recognition**



- Environmental Performance: Seattle Chocolate
  - A small and woman owned business, for reducing supply waste, donating to local food banks, and using compostable packaging
    - Reusable boxes reduced airport supply shipment waste by 80% or 3,192 cardboard boxes
    - Donated 54,822 fresh food servings to food banks through socially responsible Pink Umbrella Fund
    - Improved product packaging recoverability with certified compostable film wraps for 7.2 million truffle chocolates
